

HOW TO ACCESS VASSAR MOODLE and CLASS POSTINGS for LAPTOPS & DESKTOPS

Here are the instructions for accessing Moodle and some of the material we will discuss this semester:

1. In your browser, type: **moodle.vassar.edu**
2. Once you're there, look for this symbol:



3. In that space, type Lifelong Learning (as below) and click the blue search box:

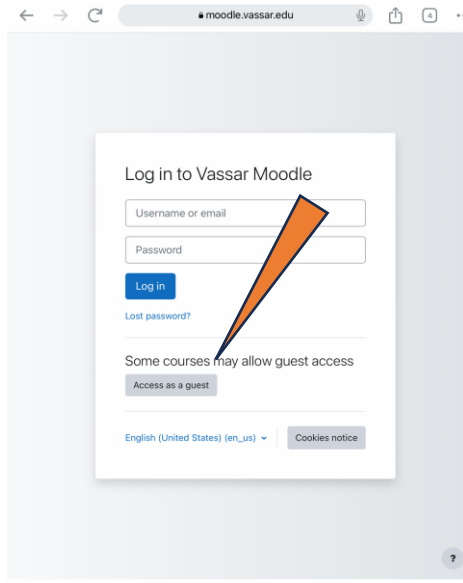
4. Now look all the way down at the **bottom right-hand corner of the page**. You'll see a question mark in a grey circle:
