Cutting mat or matte board for cutting papers

Paper cutter optional

T-square

Utility knife

Exacto knife

Scissors

Bone folder, or wooden paper folding tool

Pencil, hard, - 6H

Small plastic square

Eraser,

Metal ruler, at least 18" long

Decorative papers - cover papers, end papers

Marbled papers, suminagashi papers, paste & collage papers

Papers for signatures, text

Board for covers – matt board, watercolor paper

Linen or embroidery threads

Wax

Awls, marking and piercing

Needles, preferable with small heads, sharp or embroidery

Curved needle

Beads (optional) decorative for bookmarks

Box to hold small items, tool box

Paper clips or clothes pins

Paper tape, micropore

Brushes for paste, small cardboard scraps for spreading glue

Compass

Divider or pin tool

Burnishing stone – wax and burnish cover papers for durability

Sharpener

Template papers

Wheat paste or methyl cellulose, rice paste (Nori) archival

PVA glue - permanent

Wax paper, paste papers, old catalogues

Cloth/sponge with water for cleaning paste

Boards with weights for pressing, or

ideally, book press
